An exciting new opportunity for young learners and their families is beginning at Shalom in 2010. Year 13 is designed for students who want to finish their QCE or undertake Certificate courses across a number of different agencies (TAFE and other providers). A Year 13 Centre is being set up for the start of the 2010 school year. Young people interested in enrolling in Yr 13 @ Shalom need to make contact using the details below. Students will be accepted as Boarders or Day Students. Boarders will be given semi-independent accommodation within the College grounds. Year 13 students will also be expected to set the best behaviour and academic engagement patterns to help lead the College by example.

Year 13 will include;

- Include TAFE studies in Health, Hospitality, ICT, Construction and Administration. For three days per week.
- Exclusive classrooms (Year 13 centre) where tuition is provided to assist in completion of TAFE courses.
- Extra classes of Practical Literacy and Numeracy with qualified Literacy and Numeracy teachers and tutors.

- Students will be able to attend as day students or Boarders,
- Open to All Indigenous students in Australia who have completed year 12 in 2008 or 2009 who desire to gain more qualifications and skills to enable the transition to work to be smoother and less rushed.
